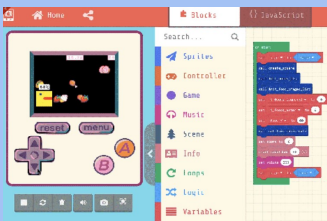
Grades K-2: Coding with Kodable

YOU WILL NEED: access to a Chromebook or laptop

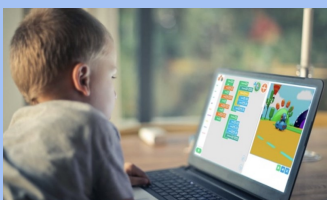
Grades K-6: Virtual Robotics with Dash
